2. I don't use an easel for gouache. I just sit in a chair. There are plenty of chairs at Star Island so don't worry about that.
3. Bug spray.....I even have tick killer socks, but I will not paint anywhere that I am forced to stand in high grass.
4. Sun Screen

We will not be able to paint outside if the threat of rain is high, but there are porches!



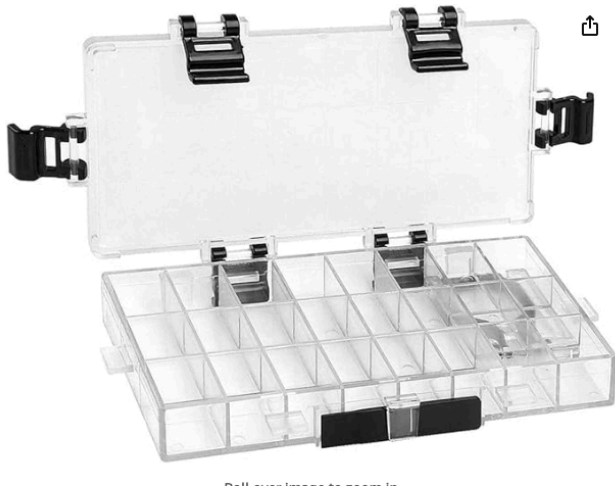
Winsor & Newton Designers Gouache

Other Gouache paints are often acrylic.
Designer Gouache means they are **not** acrylics.

Be sure you don't get acrylic gouache. The non-acrylic gouache is called designer's gouache.

You want to keep your gouache paints moist when they are out of the tube. I like this palette, because it is airtight and you can give it a little squirt with your squirt bottle to keep the paint hydrated.

I like small round brushes, because I feel I can do anything with them.



The round brushes are a number 8 and 3. The flat says it is a 5. If I am going to draw I use a pencil so I have a couple of them, an eraser and a sharpener in

my kit.

You will also need a little clip board or piece of hardboard and a clip or two to hold your paper, a water bottle, (seawater will not work, it has to be fresh), a little cup to keep water in, a little spray bottle and a few paper towels.

I love this, because I can keep it all in a tiny backpack for anytime painting.



I usually work pretty small in gouache. It is not my main medium, but I like it for doing little paintings of the world around me.

I like this pad, but I also really like to work on white. I use hot press watercolor paper, because I like a smooth paper. If you have a bunch of paper, just try it all.

It takes me about 2 hours to do a painting in gouache.
