Painting Landscape in Oils, Acrylics, Soft Pastels or Gouache with Jeneane Lunn

On bad weather days we will paint in the studio either from new photos or to finish paintings started outside. The class will include demonstrations and individual critique. Students of all abilities are welcome.

Soul "Play": Improvisation as a Spiritual Practice with Dr. Karen Rege

But improvisation is a natural act that we engage in on a daily basis in other areas of our lives. The challenge is to learn how to turn those natural improvisations into a spiritual practice in our music. This workshop will help participants determine what is preventing them from joyfully improvising music. We will "play" music in both senses of the word – making sounds and having fun doing it. We'll explore improvisation from rhythmic, melodic, and harmonic lenses. We will celebrate what makes each of us wonderfully unique. Everyone is welcome – whatever your musical skill level and whatever instrument you choose to "play" (including voice).
